Dear Mr. Burns:

I wish to amend my complaint dated November 2, 2000 re Olene Walker, Lieutenant Governor, to separate that complaint from the complaints re Governor's PAC's of the same date.

I am filing the complaint against the Lieutenant Governor based on the following Utah Election Laws:

{20A-9-202(1)(e) states that each person seeking the office of lieutenant governor shall comply with the specific declaration of candidacy requirements required by this section. Declarations were timely filed. Olene Walker became a candidate separate from the office of governor.

{20A-11-206(1)(a) and (2)(a) require a financial report to be filed. This pertains to financial information after April 29, 1991.

{20A11-206(2)(c)(ii) states that failure to file is a class B misdemeanor.

The following amounts were paid by the Governors Special Projects/Governors Spring Gala Committee Political Action Committees to Olene Walker:



There was also a \$5,000.00 check to Lt. Governor's Special Projects dated 9-15-97.

No reports were ever filed by the Lieutenant Governor. She is in violation of the Utah Election Laws. Her name should have been removed from the ballot. She is guilty of Class B misdemeanors.
